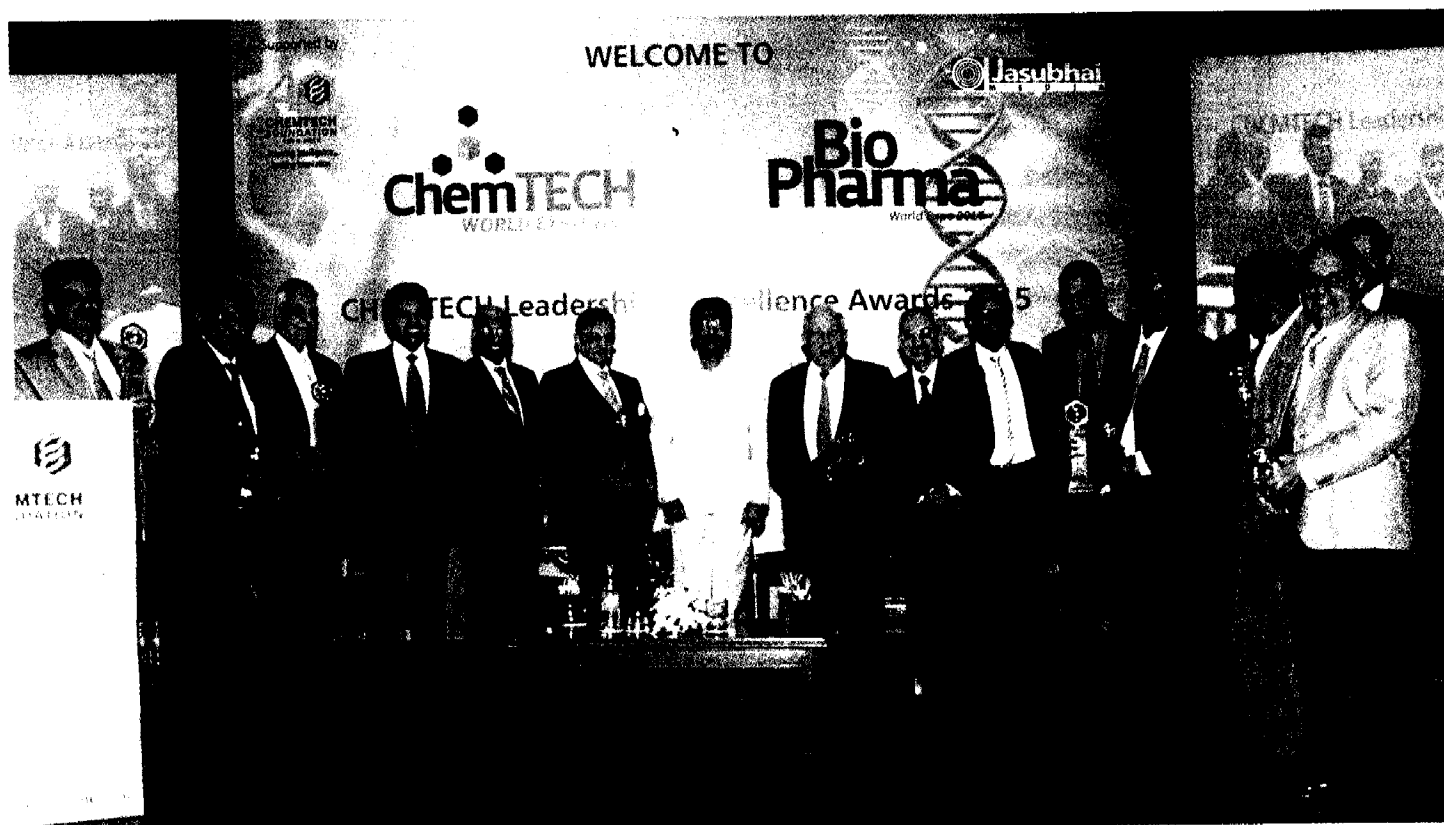

Net profit of Ion Exchange (India) rose 32.83% to Rs 14.04 crore in the quarter ended March 2015 as against Rs 10.57 crore during the previous quarter ended March 2014. Sales rose 10.08% to Rs 234.05 crore in the quarter ended March 2015 as against Rs 212.61 crore during the previous quarter ended March 2014.

For the full year, net profit rose 27.39% to Rs 26.14 crore in the year ended March 2015 as against Rs 20.52 crore during the previous year ended March 2014. Sales rose 2.69% to Rs 729.60 crore in the year ended March 2015 as against Rs 710.50 crore during the previous year ended March 2014.
